

Douglas College Factsheet – August 2009

Annual grants

- Operating grants in 2008/09 were \$53.8M, rising to \$58.3M in 2009/10, for an increase of \$4.5M.
- Operating funding to Douglas has increased by \$16.8M, from \$41.5M in 2001/02 to \$58.3M in 2009/10 – a 40.5 per cent increase.

Student spaces

- Funded a total of 8,363 student spaces in 2009/10, up from 8,141 the previous year.

- Funded spaces to Douglas College has increased by 1,075, from 7,288 in 2003/04 to 8,363 in 2009/10 – a 14.8 per cent increase.

Capital projects: Over \$53M since 2001, including:

- \$35.2M for construction of a classroom and laboratory building at the college's Coquitlam campus.
- \$7.3M (includes a \$3.4M federal contribution) for renovation and renewal of New Westminster campus buildings.

Special funding

- \$96,000 from the Aboriginal Special Projects Fund for an Aboriginal youth and care training opportunities project.
- \$97,000 for the development of online courses for the health information management program to provide more student access.
