

## Justice Institute of British Columbia Factsheet – August 2009

### **Annual grants**

- Operating grants in 2008/09 were \$8.4M, rising to \$9M for 2009/10, for an increase of \$600,000.
- Operating funding to JIBC has increased by \$2.6M, from \$6.4M in 2001/02 to \$9M in 2009/10 – a 41 per cent increase.

### **Student spaces**

- Funded a total of 2,320 student spaces for 2009-10, up from 2,319 the previous year.

### **2008-09 Utilization:**

- Funded spaces to JIBC has increased by 45, from 2,275 in 2003/04 to 2,320 in 2009/10 – a two per cent increase.

### **Capital projects:** Over \$13.5M since 2001, including:

- \$4 million (includes a \$2M federal contribution) for the construction of a driver training track.
- \$1.63 million (includes a \$804,000 federal contribution) to build a new rope rescue tower at the Maple Ridge campus, replace cooling and heating equipment at the New Westminster campus and renovate their building at Canada Education Park in Chilliwack.
- \$2.4 million for the Safety Simulation Centre which opened in May 2007.
- Over \$5 million for the acquisition of 2.32 hectares of land at the Canada Education Park.

### **Special Funding**

- \$100,000 from the Aboriginal Special Project Fund for the Indigenization of the Justice Institute of BC.
- \$50,000 from the Aboriginal Special Project Fund for the Aboriginal Student Coaching and Mentoring Project.
