

Langara College Factsheet – August 2009

Annual grants

- Operating grants in 2008/09 were \$41M, rising to \$43.9M for 2009/10, for an increase of \$2.9M.
- Operating funding to Langara has increased by \$11.2M, from \$32.7M in 2001/02 to \$43.9M in 2009/10 – a 34 per cent increase.

Student spaces

- Government has funded a total of 7,046 student spaces for 2009-10, up from 7,026 the previous year.

2008-09 Utilization:

- Funded spaces to Langara College has increased by 430, from 6,616 in 2003/04 to 7,046 in 2009/10 – a 6.5 per cent increase.

Capital projects: Over \$72M since 2001, including:

- \$29 million for the construction of a new library and classroom building.
- \$1.23 million (includes a \$609,000 federal contribution) for the remediation of the South and B buildings.
- \$2.35 million (includes a \$1.175M federal contribution) to renovate classroom and study space.

Special funding

- \$98,659 from the Aboriginal Special Projects Fund for the Learning Circles Project.

- Bachelor of science in nursing
- Bachelor of business administration with three majors
- Bachelor of recreation management
