

B.C. Institute of Technology Factsheet – Aug 2009

Annual grants

- Operating grants in 2008/09 were \$103.5 million, rising to \$112.4 million for 2009/10, for an increase of \$8.9 million.
- Operating funding to BCIT has increased by \$33 million, from \$79.4 million in 2001/02 to 112.4 million in 2009/10 – a 41.6 per cent increase.

Student spaces

- Total of 11,714 student spaces funded for 2009/10, up from 11,422 the previous year.

- Funded spaces to BCIT has increased by 1,310, from 10,404 in 2003/04 to 11,714 in 2009/10 – a 12.6 per cent increase.

Capital projects: Over \$135 million since 2001, including:

- \$39.1M (includes a \$16.3M federal contribution) to upgrade Building SW1 and surrounding areas.
- \$16.4M for construction of the BCIT Aerospace Technology Campus.
- \$8.5M for the replacement of the boiler facility and renovations to Building SE8 to accommodate a state-of-the-art boiler training facility.
- \$1.1M for new equipment for the aerospace, avionics, electrical, carpentry, welding, power engineering and machinist programs at BCIT's Burnaby and Richmond campuses, part of ALMD's \$8.75M one-time capital allocation for new trades training equipment.
